

RIIMPO318D - Conduct Civil Construction Skid Steer Loader Operations

Course Overview

This course is designed to provide participants with the skills and knowledge to conduct skid steer loader operations safely within the civil construction and mining industries.

It includes planning and preparing; conducting machine pre-operational checks; operating skid steer loaders; lifting, carrying and placing materials; selecting, removing and fitting attachments; relocate skid steer loaders; carrying out operator maintenance and cleaning up.

Duration

2 Days

Target

Individuals who would like to gain employment operating a Skid Steer Loader in the civil, construction, infrastructure or resources industries.

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age 18 years
- Basic command of English Language

Assessment

Assessment is a combination of written questions/answers and practical demonstrations.

Learning Outcomes

- Communicate and work safely with others
- Job planning and preparation
- Identify hazards associated with skid steer operations and implement hazard controls
- Conduct pre-start up operational checks
- Operate the skid steer, including:
 - Stripping / spreading topsoil and materials
 - Backfilling
 - Lifting, loading vehicles
 - Excavations
 - Mixing materials
 - The removal and fitting of attachments
 - Shutting down and securing the skid steer
 - Relocate the machine
 - Carry out operator maintenance, and
 - Job / worksite clean up
