Entry Requirements

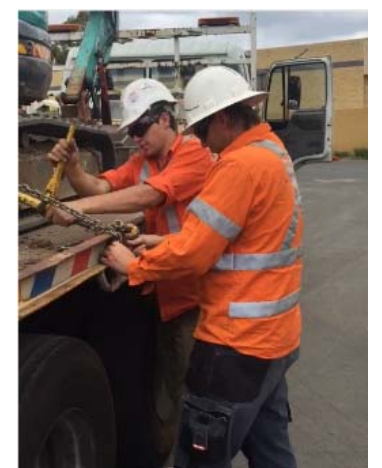
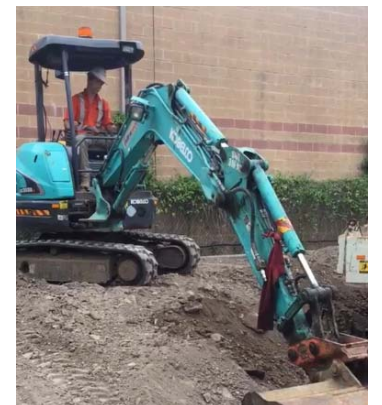
- Minimum age 18 years

Assessment

Assessment is a combination of written questions/answers and practical demonstrations.

- Communicate and work safely with others
- Job planning and preparation
- Identify hazards associated and implement hazard controls
- Conduct pre-start operational checks
- Systematic and efficient control of vehicle functions
- Lifting, carrying and placing materials
- Stripping / spreading topsoil and materials
- Excavations, trenching and backfilling
- Mixing materials
- Selecting, removing and fitting attachments
- Relocating equipment and clean, check and maintain plant and equipment
- Clean up work area
