TLILIC2001 – Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck

Course Overview

This course provides the skills and knowledge required to operate a forklift, including checking forklift condition, driving the forklift to fulfil operational requirements, monitoring site conditions and monitoring and maintaining forklift performance. A Workbook will be sent to you for review before course commencement.



Duration (2 options)

3 Days (2 Days training and 1 day for SafeWork NSW Assessment)

Or

2 Days (online assessment + Day 1 practical training + Day 2 for SafeWork NSW Assessment)



Target

Individuals working in a warehouse or an occupation where forklift driving is required and who do not hold a current High Risk Work Licence of LF Class Forklift.

Entry Requirements

- Minimum age 18 years
- Basic command of English Language
- Revision of Forklift Workbook before commencement of course or online assessment



Assessment

Assessment is a combination of written questions/answers and practical demonstrations.

Learning Outcomes

- Use appropriate methodology of determining the weight of a load
- Have knowledge of Commonwealth, state or territory WH&S legislation, standards relevant to the safe operation for the forklift trucks
- Identify forklift characteristics and capabilities (including use of load data plates)
- Identify hierarchy of hazard identification and control
- Understand organisational and workplace standards, requirements, policies and procedures for conducting operations for the crane class
- Identify procedures for the recording, reporting and maintenance of workplace records and information
- Conduct Forklift truck operations and safe operating techniques
- Identify typical routine problems encountered in the operation of the crane and equipment and adjustments required for correction



TLILIC2001 – Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck

Participant Requirements

Wear steel cap boots, a hard hat, safety glasses, long pants and hi visibility shirt/vest. You will also need wet weather gear if required.

On Completion

Upon successful completion, participants will be:

- Awarded with a Statement of Attainment for TLILIC2001 – Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck
- Eligible to apply to SafeWork NSW for their (LF) Licence to Operate a Forklift Truck. This is a National High Risk Work (HRW) Licence. The application must be made within sixty (60) days at a NSW Post Office. You will be required to provide one hundred (100) points of identification (ID) plus a passport sized photo with your application.
- The cost of the application of the High Risk Work License is \$72.50 per class of Licence, as of July 2017
